We are writing to inform you about a student survey that will be administered at your child's school called the *Comprehensive School Climate Inventory*. This survey, developed by the National School Climate Center, asks students about their experiences in school. Having direct information from students is vitally important for administrators when developing quality school improvement plans.

Students' identities will be completely confidential. Teachers or administrators will never see individual responses to survey questions. They will only see summary level responses, such as the percentage of students' who agree homework assignments help them learn the course material.

Please be aware that under the Protection of Pupil Rights Act, 20 U.S.C. Section 1232(c) (1) (A), you have the right to review a copy of the questions asked of your student(s). Survey questions can be viewed in the Main Office of your student's school.
